## Sirloin Adds Music to Its Nightly Menu

Although an occupant of Severance Center for over two years, the chain-operated Sirloin and Saddle, Taylor and Mayfield Rds., Cleveland Heights, this week inaugurated an entertainment policy for diners and imbibers who prefer not to eat, drink and run.



The atmosphere will remain subdued, however, for the music fare presented nightly by accordionist Rick Salerno is soft-pedaled and geared exclusively for those who seek nocturnal surroundings that are sedate and musically unobtrusive. Beginning at 8 weeknights Salerno plays his first set in the dining room, ambling off later to the lounge as music man for any dancers in the house. The lounge had been utilized rather unpretentiously until now, for it functioned primarily as a haven for pre-dinner drinkers.

The decor of both rooms, consisting of carpeted floors, beamed ceilings, red painted acoustical tile and walls of old barnwood, has a western theme, minus over-emphasis on the rustic. Handsome decorative plaques and flickering wall lights lend a further elegance, making the room somewhat formal though comfortably unstuffy.

### Day-time at the Gazette

Trying to infuse some quiet charm to the gabby camaraderie of the Hollenden House's Gazette Lounge, 610 Superior Ave., at cocktail hour time is Bonnie Daye's nightly assignment—an unenviable chore, for most of the clientele at that hour is usually too vocally preoccupied to pay great heed.

The tempo subsides a bit by 7:30, however, giving Miss Daye a chance to display her musical wares as singer and accompanist. She succeeds quite well under these reversed conditions for her stylishly delivered vocalizing and spunky personality become immediately evident.

Miss Daye is a former beauty contestant who once was Miss Grand Rapids, later runner-up to Miss Michigan. While in Grand Rapids she had her own TV and radio shows and for a time served as program director for a local radio station.
